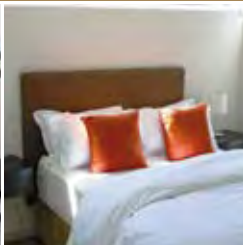

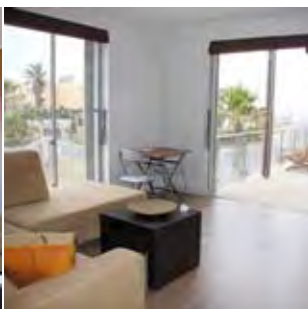
Modern and comfortable accommodation

All apartments are furnished with a kitchenette (ceramic stove top, microwave, toaster, kettle and fridge).

The bathrooms are equipped with a shower, hairdryer and a power point for electric razors. Every apartment has a flat screen satellite TV with German channels ARD & ZDF as well as DSTV channels. There is broadband wireless internet access in all apartments free of charge. Laundry facilities are available to all our guests. We welcome you to make use of the garden & outdoor lounge, the 25 m swimming pool and hot & cold outdoor shower. Your car can be parked on the property or if desired in the garage. Surfing equipment can be stored safely in our secured garage and wetsuits can be hung up to dry behind the house.

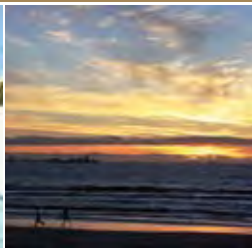

Golfers find the Milnerton Golf course (18-holes) in walking distance from the guest house and cyclists and runners can start directly from the guest house.

Sunset Beach is one of the safest regions in the Western Cape. The guest house has an alarm system and Sunset Beach is controlled 24 hours by a private security company.





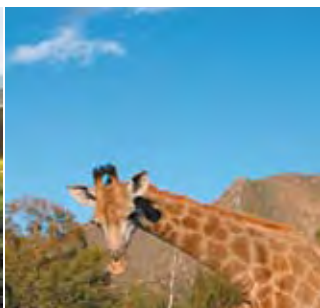
Leisure activities in and around Cape Town

There are numerous training routes in the Cape region for mountain bikers and cyclists, especially around the Cape of Good Hope and in the Winelands of Franschoek, Stellenbosch and Wellington. Every year in March the biggest and most beautiful cycle race in the world – the “Pick’n Pay Cape Argus Cycle Tour” takes place.

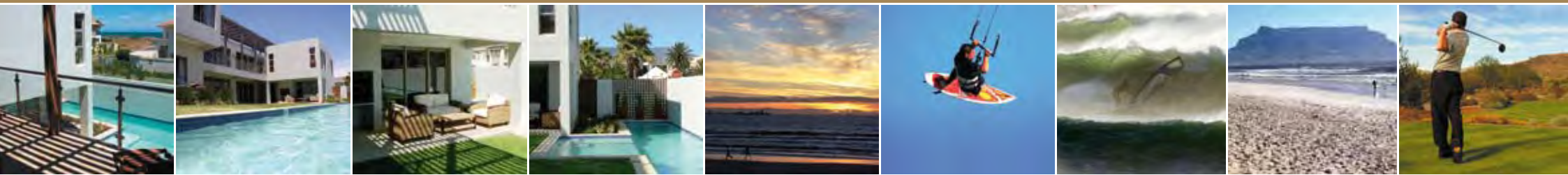

Da Heim Guest House Sunset Beach, Cape Town

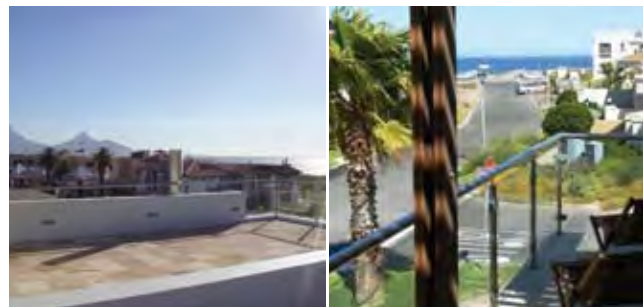
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
